

# STRENGTHEN THE FAITHFUL (Wartime Miracles Leaflet)

*"All Churches working together for revival"*

To the Leadership Team.

I want to draw your attention to a free Leaflet which is being distributed to Churches/Congregations Nationwide, because it is a resource which you also may find of great use. It provides powerful examples of answered prayer, and from the responses we are receiving, we know that this Leaflet is greatly strengthening people in their faith.

Over the past few months thousands of Church Secretaries received through the post two copies of this Leaflet for prayer and reflection and copies have been posted to Pastors/Clergy for use in their teaching and preaching ministry. The distribution of this Leaflet is a national **nondenominational campaign**. Copies have been posted to over 25,000 churches across all the major denominations throughout England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. (The Church of England, The Church of Ireland, The Church in Wales, The Methodist Church, The Baptist Church, The Church of Scotland, the Irish Presbyterian Church, as well as Elim Pentecostal and Community Churches).

The purpose of the Leaflet is to give true Christians hope, encouragement and reassurance, which is so greatly needed in these unsettling and frightening times. Many will find the examples of answered prayer particularly helpful and relevant in the light of the blockbuster film *Dunkirk* and the film *Darkest Hour*. Both these films graphically depict Britain as it struggled for survival and the Leaflet reveals fascinating details of how God answered the prayers of the Nation in order to bring deliverance. When reading it, your particular attention is drawn to the statement issued by the Archbishop of Canterbury at the time, as well as the one by the Bishop of Chelmsford, both quoted on page four.

From the information we are receiving back, churches are using the Leaflet in a wide variety of ways most appropriate to their local situation. For example some Pastors/Clergy have used the illustrations as sermon material, other churches have printed parts of the Leaflet in their church magazine/bulletin and some have placed it on their website. Home groups have also used it as study material and as dramatic examples of answered prayer. We have had several reports of ministers distributing the Leaflet to their congregations on Remembrance Sunday last year.

Although this is an nondenominational campaign aimed primarily at Britain and Northern Ireland, we at *Strengthen the Faithful* are now receiving requests for the Leaflet from other parts of the world; Canada, USA, Australia, New Zealand, Nova Scotia, Tasmania and South Sudan. Interestingly we have also been contacted by several Christian schools.

Instructions on how to obtain an electronic version are at the end of the Leaflet. The quickest and easiest option is then to print/email your own copies from the attachment that will be sent to you. However, you may also ask for copies to be posted to you.
